STOP BUSH !

The war criminal George Bush is coming to Britain for a state visit on 19th – 21st November. Let's make sure the warmonger knows he's not welcome in Britain. In his brief presidency, he has already brought us the following achievements:

- **Iraq:** An illegal invasion, which has brought untold devastation, killed up to 10,000 civilians and many more conscripts, as well as shattering the UN and splitting the international community.
- **Afghanistan:** An assault on one of the world's poorest countries, following which the only real change is a new American oil pipeline, and a rejuvenated heroin trade. Fundamentalist warlords still dominate the country, and the Taliban are regrouping.
- **Palestine:** He has given his full support to his fellow war criminal Ariel Sharon's murderous illegal occupation and repression.
- **Guantanamo Bay:** Merely one of the most striking examples of Bush's utter contempt for the rule of law, and the Geneva Conventions on the treatment of war prisoners.
- **Kyoto:** The Kyoto Treaty was a minimal step to combat climate change, but Bush has refused to sign on behalf of the globe's biggest polluter, despite 150 other states doing so.
